SOUTH ACRES PARK

2 Gazebo

- Provide an intimate gathering space to act as a destination for small groups, a resting place, provide shade and shelter from rain, and a landmark within the park.

6 Fenced Dog Park

- Allows for off-leash exercise for dogs. Dog park to be divided into two sections allowing for large dog and small dog play areas.

5 Community Garden

- Proposed community garden to be located near South Acres Road entrance. New expanded and formalized parking area in this location.

9 Bike Rack

- Provide bike racks in key park locations offering secure bike parking solutions for cyclists encouraging alternative modes of transportation.

3 Pavilion

- Provide a gathering space for larger groups enhancing the park's outdoor amenities offering a location for public events, as well as, a rental opportunity for private parties.

10 Bottle Fill Station

- Encourage users to reuse water bottles, save money, stay hydrated, and protect the environment by offering a water station with water fountain, bottle fill, and pet bowl.

11 Rest Area Node

- Provide seating nooks with benches along the loop trail to offer a respite for walkers/joggers and gathering nodes for social connections throughout the Park.

- Provide a shaded area with picnic tables offering users a place to sit, relax, eat, play games, and rest within the Park. Located near the new pavilion and playground to support overlapping compatible uses within the Park.

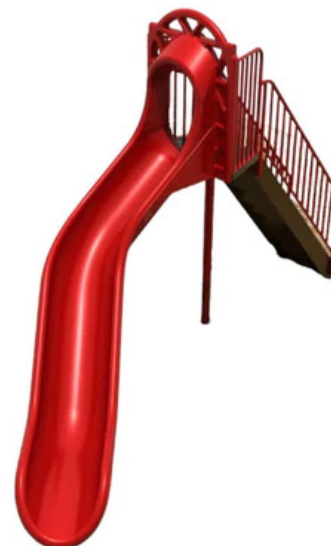
Inclusive Swings
