Concept Plan Features

## 2 Picnic Area

- Provide a shaded area(s) with picnic tables, benches, and trash receptacles offering users a place to sit, relax, eat, play games, and rest within the Park. Located near the refurbished gazebo, new pavilion, playground, and natural play nodes to support overlapping compatible uses within the Park.



## 3 Rain Garden

- Incorporate green infrastructure solutions, including rain gardens to collect rain water and reduce runoff. A rain garden is a depressed area in the Park that collects water allowing it to soak into the ground at specific locations. These can be planted with grasses and flowering perennials making beautiful gardens that also serve as stormwater management.



## 8 Berm Seating

- The incorporation of grass berm seating takes advantage of the topography from the existing design offering flexible seating doubling as climbable play features.

## 6 Bike Rack

- Provide bike racks in key park locations offering secure bike parking solutions for cyclists encouraging alternative modes of transportation.

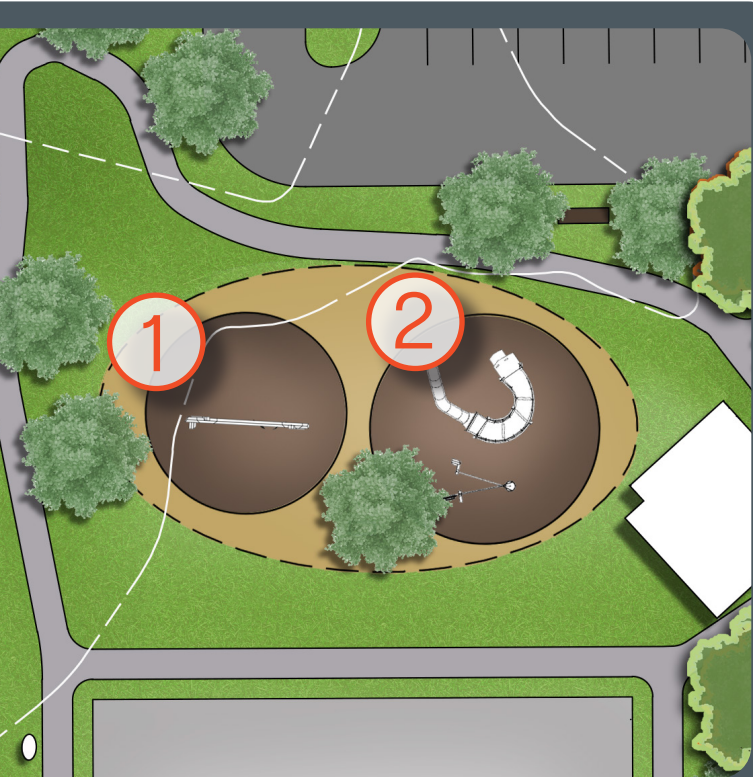
## 1 6' Wide Walking Path

- Provide accessible walking paths for all users. The walking path system is a series of overlapping loops providing opportunities for passive recreation as well as pedestrian circulation.

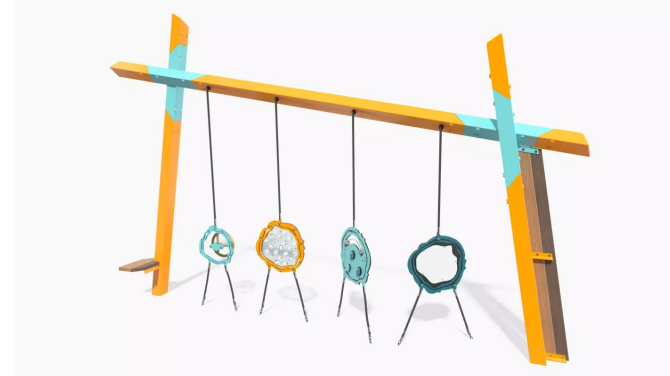
